

## Request for Delivery of Certain Notices by E-Mail

**Texas Property Tax Code Sec. 1.086.** On the written request of the owner of a residential property that is occupied by the owner as the owner's principal residence, the Chief Appraiser of the appraisal district in which the property is located shall send each notice required by this title related to the following to the e-mail address of the owner:

- 1) A change in value of the property
- 2) The eligibility of the property for an exemption; or
- 3) The grant, denial, cancellation or other change in the status of an exemption or exemption application applicable to the property.

All documents submitted to the district by the property owner must be delivered in an Adobe Acrobat (pdf) file or as a jpg or tiff image file. All documents must have an original signature.

It is the property owner's responsibility to provide a valid or updated email address to the district at the above address or email.

**An email confirming your request will be sent prior to sending the first notice.**
